Sub:- Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Department - FMD\_CP - 2017-18 - 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Foot & Mouth Disease Vaccination Programme from 29<sup>th</sup> December 2017 - 13<sup>th</sup> January 2018 in Telangana under FMD Control Programme - Certain Guidelines - Issued - Regarding.

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The attention of the District Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Officers noted in the address entry is invited to the subject cited, and it is informed that, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Foot & Mouth Disease Vaccination Programme for the year 2017-18 will be taken up from 29<sup>th</sup> December 2017 - 13<sup>th</sup> January 2018 under **FMD-CP**. The DVAHOs are requested to start the vaccination programme invariably from 29<sup>th</sup> December as the immunity period lasts for about 6 months from the last vaccination date to ensure animals are protected in time.

The guidelines/ precautions and operational manual are enclosed here with for effective implementation of Foot & Mouth Disease Vaccination Programme in the districts. Vaccination details shall be entered in separate registers. Proper acquaintance should be obtained from the farmer under **FMD-CP** separately. The details of the beneficiaries should be recorded in the vaccination register i.e., Name of the farmer, father's name, caste, mobile no., Aadhar No., No. of cattle, No. of Buffaloes and signature. The vaccinated animal should be identified by marking **GREEN colour** at the base of horn.

The Government has released funds for implementation of FMD\_CP and amount towards logistics are released @1.45 per each vaccination (copy enclosed) and the remaining @1.05 will be released after DTA authorization. The expenditure for the FMD\_CP may be booked as per the Model expenditure work sheet in the Annexure and on priority basis technical and administrative sanctions should be taken from Head Office for items like needles, syringes, cold chain, etc. The remuneration to vaccinators and assistants hired for FMD\_CP should be credited to the bank accounts invariably.

The proper recording and maintenance of records should strictly followed as the World Assembly of delegates of OIE has approved that India is recognized as

having an official control programme for Foot and Mouth Disease on 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2015 and endorsed the FMD Control programme in accordance with the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code (2014). These records may have to be produced to Government of India upon request. Further, the Govt. of Telangana has issued notification declaring the state as FMD free zone and also submitted dossier which is for active consideration at OIE Paris. OIE team may visit at time, therefore concerned all records should be properly maintained.

A per the Government of India instructions all the DVAHO's in the state are requested to instruct the field staff to liaise with the concerned staff of the Institutions, Universities, Colleges, State Farms, Gaushalas in their jurisdiction for proper implementation of the FMD Vaccination programme and also to include the vaccination details in the district data.

Therefore, all the District Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Officers are requested to **send a detailed day wise, village wise programme action plan to Head office by 14-12-17** and follow the guidelines / precautions including Government of India guidelines scrupulously for effective implementation of Foot and Mouth Disease Vaccination Programme and submit Village, Mandal and District wise Vaccination particulars after completion of vaccination Programme (Both Hard & Soft copy) along with photo graphs, press clipping and success stories without fail.
