Sub:- Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Department - Disease Control Strategy - Vaccination & Deworming Calendar for the year 2018-19 - Certain instructions - Issued - Regarding.

Livestock plays an important role in daily life of rural poor and protection of livestock health is the primary duty of every Veterinarian. The health of the Livestock can be protected by taking up timely preventive vaccinations and control measures. The preventive health calendar for livestock and poultry vaccinations and Deworming for creating disease free zone for the year 2018-19 for the economically important diseases is prepared and enclosed herewith.

The following disease control strategy will be adopted in the state for the year 2018-19:

- 1) **HS, BQ vaccinations in Bovines:** The DVAHO's are requested to take up vaccination in the following categories of villages and their susceptible population as per 2012 census.
 - a) Outbreak villages - recording Outbreak in past 5 years.
 - b) Villages surrounding outbreak villages upto 3 Km radius.
 - c) Villages along interstate border, shandies & abattoirs, along the livestock movement routes, villages on banks of rivers, streams, lakes and water bodies villages surrounding Forests, Wildlife sanctuaries, National parks etc and villages around 10 Km radius of Government Livestock farms and FSBS farms (Karimnagar).
- 2) **Foot & Mouth Disease in Bovines:** Mass vaccination of all the eligible bovines will be taken up twice in the year at 6 monthly intervals under the FMD Control Programme.
- 3) **Vaccinations in Sheep (ET, PPR, Sheep Pox & Bluetongue):** For effective control and eradication of the sheep diseases, all the inducted sheep should be vaccinated against Enterotoxaemia, PPR (along with existing sheep population), Sheep Pox & Bluetongue.

In the existing sheep population, susceptible population in the endemic & target villages will be vaccinated against ET, Sheep pox and Blue tongue. In case of repeat vaccination / booster dose the immunity period of vaccine and last vaccination should be taken into consideration.

The newly inducted sheep will be dewormed and vaccinated as per the guidelines by giving priority to the disease incidence as per the month/season of induction. The required quantity may be procured and kept in cold storage as per induction plan.

The District Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Officers (DVAHO's) are requested to ensure strict implementation of the schedule without any deviation duly following the guidelines given below:

1. Ensure that all the AI calves, animals inducted under various schemes and their progeny are vaccinated.
2. Vaccination teams may be formed to conduct vaccinations in the villages. The services of Gopalmitras, Goat scouts, CLEW workers, MYTHRI etc.

should be utilized for vaccinating all the susceptible population within the stipulated time.

3. Logistics:- All logistic arrangements like Vaccine, cold chain, Deworming medicines, syringes, needles, cold chain facilities etc. should be made available well in advance.
4. Publicity:- They should give wide publicity and create awareness among farmers regarding the programme.
5. They should ensure completion of these programmes within the scheduled time by proper prior action plan and by involvement of all the staff.
6. The Public representatives like Ministers, MLAs, MLCs, Local public representatives etc. should be involved to make these programmes successful.

Therefore, the District Veterinary & Animal Husbandry Officers are requested to take up the programmes as per schedule and furnish report to Head Office without fail.
